ABOUT THE HOME

Westhaven Community was established in 1912 as a non-profit Christian Home. The Board of Directors consists of nine members elected from the Evangelical Free Church's Central District Conference plus the Director of Operations. Westhaven Community is licensed by the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals and complies with all regulations. All residents – Medicare, Medicaid and private pay - are welcome in the Westhaven Community.

Ninety resident rooms are private with a shared bathroom, eight resident rooms are private with a private bathroom and two rooms are doubles. We are certified for 100 residents. Sitting/activity areas are provided throughout the building for family/friend visits, cable TV, reading and relaxation. Westhaven Community maintains a full staff of employees for the daily care of residents and facility operations. There are licensed personnel on duty 24 hours a day. The support staff consists of Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses, Certified Nurse's Aides, Certified Medication Aides, Maintenance, Laundry, Housekeeping, Dietary, Social Services, Activities, Chaplain and Administration.

A complete schedule of activities such as exercises, crafts, educational programs, games, music, and parties are scheduled by the Activity Department. Our full-time Chaplain facilitates a variety of worship opportunities on Sundays and during the week. Area churches are also involved in providing for the individual needs of the Westhaven Community members. Residents also have the option of listening to local churches heard Sunday mornings on radio station KWBG (1590 AM) if they wish. Residents attend all religious services and activities on a voluntary basis.

Delicious meals are prepared and served in four attractive dining rooms. A dietician is employed by Westhaven Community. Juice and snack carts make the rounds to all residents in early afternoon and evening. Reservations for guest meals can be made at a nominal cost. In addition, coffee and treats are served in Central Bistro dining room every afternoon.
